- Sales, sign-up, or other performance metrics reported by clients

How we Collect your Data

Data is collected directly from you via communications, and agreements, and automatically through website analytics tools (Google Analytics, Microsoft Clarity).

Purpose of Data Processing

We use your data to:

- Deliver and maintain website services
- Manage client accounts and communications
- Process payments and commissions
- Track website performance relevant to billing
- Comply with legal obligations



Legal Basis for Processing

We process your data based on:

- Contractual necessity to provide our services
- Legitimate interests for performance tracking and billing
- Consent where applicable (e.g., cookies)

Data Storage and Security

Your data is securely stored using Microsoft 365 (including Azure services) and HostEurope hosting infrastructure. We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your data.

Data Retention

We retain your personal data during our business relationship and delete it 30 days after service termination, regardless of further communication.

Sharing Your Data

We may share your data with:

- Payment processors (PayPal)
- Hosting providers (HostEurope)
- Analytics providers (Google Analytics, Microsoft Clarity)
- We ensure all third parties comply with UK data protection standards.

International Transfers

Data stored in Microsoft 365 and other services may be transferred internationally with appropriate safeguards in place.
